

JOB LANE BIBLE

The Job Lane Bible has a new display case constructed by Jan van Steenwijk. The new case not only places the Bible in position for better viewing, but also is designed to keep it protected from deterioration. The Job Lane Bible is on loan from the Bedford Historical Society. Printed in 1723, the Job Lane Bible is the only item in the Job Lane Museum unique to the Lane family. The Bible was undoubtedly read by Lieutenant Job Lane, who fought at the Old North Bridge in 1775 with the Bedford Minuteman Company. Job Lane's signature is on the Bible.
